Zechariah, filled with the Holy Spirit, prophesied:

Praise the Lord! (v.68a)

- (#1) God comes to save His people through the birth of His chosen Savior King (vv. 68–69).
 - A. He has visited and redeemed His people (v. 68)
- B. He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of His servant David (v. 69)
- (#2) God keeps His Word and fulfills His Promises (vv. 70–73).
 - A. *As He spoke* (v. 70)
 - B. To Show the Mercy Promised (v. 72a)
 - C. To Remember His Holy Covenant (v. 72b)
 - D. The Oath that He Swore (v. 73)
- (#3) God saves His People to Serve Him in Joy Forever (vv. 74–75).
 - A. That we Being Delivered...Might Serve Him without Fear (v. 74)
 - B. In Holiness...before Him all our Days (v. 75)
- (#4) God wrought a miracle for the birth of John the Baptist to point to the greater miracle of the birth of Jesus, who is the Lord God, the Most High (vv. 76–79).
 - A. You, Child, will be called the prophet of the Most High (v. 76a)

- B. You will go before the LORD to prepare His Ways (v. 76b)
- C. To Give Knowledge of Salvation to His People (v. 77)
 - 1) Because of the Tender mercy of Our God (v. 78a)
 - 2) Whereby the Sunrise shall visit us from on High (v. 78b)
 - 3) To guide our Feet into the Way of Peace (v. 79)
